- a. Input regarding street parking on Aqueduct between Parthenia and Nordoff
 Apparently residents from outlying areas are parking there, all hours, but particularly at night.
 In addition to depriving the local homeowners of parking in front of their residences
 The non local parkers are contributing to a significant littering issue

As well as intermittent non functional vehicles being worked on there
Also trash cans have been placed on curbs and vehicles parked, resulting in no trash pickup
Same issue with blocking mailboxes
A request was made to facilitate restricted parking, either by residents & guests only
And/ or a general time of day/ night restriction

- b. A report was made by a resident regarding roaches emanating from a neighbors property The resident has had her property treated twice by a professional exterminating company but the problem persists. J.McGovern will schedule a meeting on site with her to evaluate the situation.
