The North Hills West Neighborhood Council voted on May 18, 2023, to oppose Ordinance Number 187803 which was adopted by the Los Angeles City Council on March 14, 2023

The North Hills West Neighborhood Council opposes this for twofold reasons: First, there has been insufficient time for Neighborhood Councils to register their concerns regarding this ordinance.

Second, Neighborhood Council Members are not employees of the City of Los Angeles but elected and appointed community members, therefore the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment has no authority to “enforce” Neighborhood Councils regarding mandatory training.
