The North Hills West Neighborhood Council concurs with the City Council's support of Senate Bill 434 (Min), which would require California's top ten public transit operators to collect and publish survey data as a critical first step towards addressing street harassment, improving passenger safety, and increasing transit ridership. However, the collection of data is only the first step in ensuring the safety of passengers on public transit. As recent media attention has highlighted that the Los Angeles Metro trains are particularly unsafe. Therefore, the North Hills West Neighborhood Council also requests that additional police personnel be deployed to ensure the safety of Metro passengers.
