Summary of Motions Introduced (*New Legislation*)

Council File 23-0894, County Executive Committee / Blue Ribbon Commission on Homelessness / City Enhanced Comprehensive Homeless Strategy / Homeless Policy Oversight (*Blumenfield – Krekorian – Raman - Yaroslavsky*): Introduced August 23, 2023 and referred to Housing and Homelessness Committee. Motion is instructing the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to report back with details on how the County's Executive Committee would function and with recommendations to establish a process that enables the Executive Committee to be informed by the policies set by the Los Angeles City Council.

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Council File 23-0867, FireWorks Buyback Program / LAPD Bureaus / 4th of July / Expansion (*Rodriguez – Harris-Dawson*): Introduced August 18, 2023 and referred to Public Safety Committee. Motion is instructing the Police Department (LAPD), with the assistance of the Fire Department, City Administrative Officer and the Chief Legislative

Analyst to report to Council on resources required and potential funding sources for operating the Fireworks Buyback Program in every LAPD Bureau for the 4th of July holiday, as well as with a plan to expand the Program to include more locations and other firework heavy holidays.

Take Action:

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Council File 23-0864, Rapidly Spreading Wildfires / Fire Prevention / Emergency Response / Public Information (Krekorian - Rodriguez): Introduced August 18, 2023 and referred to Public Safety Committee. Motion is instructing the LAFD, EMD and LAPD to report to the Council on what measures the City has taken to reduce the risk of rapidly spreading wildfires.

Take Action:

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Council File 23-0002-S90, Lived Experience Advocacy Services / Supplemental Security Income / Benefit Reductions / Homeless Services Delivery System / 2023-24 (Blumenfield – Raman - Park): Introduced August 25, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT and/or SPONSOR legislation to abate benefit reductions for lived experiences advocates in SSI or other programs when receiving compensation for providing services to better the homeless services delivery system.

Take Action:

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Council File 23-0002-S89, AB 800 (Ortega) / Workplace Readiness Week / State Public School Observance / Worker Rights / Fair Wage / Safe Workplace

(McOsker – Padilla): Introduced August 25, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 800 (Ortega) which would require the state's public schools to observe Workplace Readiness Week.

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Council File 23-0002-S88, San Gabriel Mountains Foothills and Rivers / Permanent Protections / Antiquities Act (Raman - Yaroslavsky):

Introduced August 23, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for the permanent protections of the San Gabriel Mountains Foothills and Rivers with federal designations and/or the use of Presidential authority under the Antiquities Act, that enhance health, air quality, water supply and water quality, recreational opportunities, and the quality of life for the residents of Los Angeles.

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Council File 23-0002-S86, AB 249 (Holden) / k-12 / Daycare Facilities / Potable Water System Outlets / Lead Testing / State Board of Education / Citation

Issuance Authority Expansion (Hutt – Blumenfield - Yaroslavsky): Introduced August 22, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 249 (Holden), a requirement to test for lead in potable water system outlets at all public k-12 and daycare facilities and require immediate notice and remediation of sources of lead exposure under penalty of citation by the State Board of Education.

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Council File 23-0002-S85, AB 593 (Haney) / California Energy Commission / Emission Reduction Strategy / Building Sector / Net-Zero Greenhouse Gas Emissions / 2045 (Hutt – Blumenfield - Yaroslavsky) Introduced August 18, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 593 (Haney) which would require the California Energy Commission, on or before June 1, 2024, to identify an emission reduction strategy, with milestones, for the building sector to support achieving the net-zero greenhouse gas emission by 2045 and require the California Energy Commission to implement the strategy by July 1, 2025.
