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**Council File 23-1200-S9, Erroll Southers / Board of Police Commissioners / Commission Appointment (*Mayor*):** Introduced February 10, 2023 and referred to Public Safety Committee. Mayor's report is relative to the appointment of Dr. Erroll Southers to the Board of Police Commissioners, for the term ending June 30, 2025.

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**Council File 23-1200-S8, Rasha Shields / Board of Police Commissioners / Commission Appointment (*Mayor*):** Introduced February 10, 2023 and referred to Public Safety Committee. Mayor report is relative to the appointment of Rasha Shields to the Board of Police Commissioners for the term ending June 30, 2026.

Introduced February 16, 2023 and referred to Transportation Committee. Mayor report is relative to the re-appointment of Ms. Connie Llanos as the Interim General Manager, Department of Transportation.

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**Council File 23-0166, Prevent Human Trafficking / Homeless Youth / Community Investment for Families Department / Youth Development Department (*Park – Rodriguez*):**

Introduced February 14, 2023 and referred to Neighborhoods and Community Enrichment Committee. The Motion is instructing the Community Investment for Families Department, the Youth Development Department, with assistance from the Office of the Chief Legislative Analyst, and other departments as appropriate, to investigate and report on solution to prevent human trafficking among homeless youth in the City of Los Angeles

**Take Action:**

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**Council File 23-0151, Lead Hazard Remediation Program / Lead-Based Paint / Low-Income Households / U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) / Notice of Funding Opportunity / Application (*Raman – Yaroslavsky*):**

Introduced February 10, 2023 and referred to Housing and Homelessness Committee. Motion is authorizing the General Manager of LAHD or designee, to apply for, accept

and execute a new grant agreement with HUD, including all certifications and other required documents.

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**Council File 23-0148, Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV) / American Rescue Plan / Department of Housing and Urban Development / People Experiencing Homelessness / Permanent Housing / Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (Raman - Yaroslavsky):** Introduced February 10, 2023 and referred to Housing and Homelessness Committee. Motion is directing the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA), with the assistance of the Los Angeles Homelessness Services Authority (LAHSA) and any City departments, as needed, to report back within 30 days with a plan to address the factors within its control that cause the most significant delays in moving voucher-utilization and the speed with which voucher placements are made.

**Take Action:**

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**Council File 23-0002-S31, Catalytic Converter / Theft and Resale / S. 2024 / Preventing Auto Recycling Thefts (PART) Act (Blumenfield – Lee – Rodriguez):** Introduced February 15, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for legislation similar to S. 2024, the Preventing Auto Recycling Thefts (PART) Act.

**Take Action:**

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**Council File 23-0002-S30, SB 4 (Wiener) / Affordable Housing on Faith Lands Act / Expedited Development (Yaroslavsky – Raman):** Introduced February 15, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Senate Bill 4 (Wiener), Affordable Housing on Faith Land Acts

**Take Action:**

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**Council File 23-0002-S29, Prohibit Sale of Vehicles Without Catalytic Converter / Etched Engraved Vehicle Identification Number / Legislative Program (Blumenfield – Lee – Soto-Martinez):** Introduced February 15, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for SB 55 (Umberg), which would prohibit the sale of vehicles without an etched or engraved vehicle identification number on the catalytic converter.

**Take Action:**

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**Council File 23-0002-S28, AB 28 (Gabriel) / Firearms and Ammunition Tax / Protection Against Gun Violence (Park – Krekorian):** Introduced February 15, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 28 (Gabriel) which expresses the intent of the

Legislature to enact legislation that would enact a tax on firearms and ammunition to protect against gun violence.

**Take Action:**

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**Council File 23-0002-S27, 2023-24 State Legislative Program / Taxpayer Protection and Government Accountability Act (Krekorian – Blumenfield – Harris-Dawson – Hutt – Raman – Soto-Martinez):** Introduced February 14, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program OPPOSITION to the “Taxpayer Protection and Government Accountability Act,” which would amend the State Constitution to impose restrictions on the ways in which state and local governments can levy taxes, fees, and other charges.
