Council File 23-0738, Lead and Mold Inspections and Testing / Rent Stabilization Ordinance (RSO) / Systematic Code Enforcement Program (SCEP) / Regulatory and Code Compliance Bureau (*Harris-Dawson – Hutt – Raman -Hernandez – Soto-Martinez*) Introduced June 28, 2023 and referred to Housing and Homelessness Committee. Motion is instructing the LAHD, with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Chief Legislative Analyst, to report back in 60 days with recommendations to require lead and mold inspections as part of SCEP beginning July 1, 2025.

Motion is requesting the Citty Attorney with the assistance of the Department of Building and Safety, to draft an ordinance amending Section 91.105 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to add an exemption for shade structures installed at Department of Recreation and Parks facilities with an area up to 1,300 square feet provided that a structural engineer has determined that the structure meets all applicable safety standards.

Carrillo), the Orphan Well-Prevention Act, which requires that buyers and operators of oil and gas wells post a bond sufficient to cover the full cost of plugging, abandonment and site restoration after production stops.

Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for SB512 (Bradford) which would exclude from the term terms "gross receipts" and "sales price" under the Sales and Use Tax Law the amount of the cannabis excise tax imposed under the Cannabis Tax Law and the amount of any tax imposed by a city or county on the privilege of engaging in commercial cannabis activity.
