12.Discussion and possible action to approve a Neighborhood Purposes Grant in the amount of \$850.00 to the Southern California Preparedness Foundation for the 10th Annual Valley Disaster Preparedness Fair.

This Emergency and Disaster Preparedness Fair, which regularly draws over 3,000 participants, benefits the Neighborhood Council and surrounding communities by increasing neighborhood awareness, providing education and training, and enhancing whole community disaster preparedness. This event is family-friendly, open to the public, and free to attendees. Free Family Emergency Preparedness (EP) Starter kits (while supplies last), will be given to registered families attending the Fair. Additionally, a free lunch is offered while supplies last. The grant money will be used to procure supplies, services, and rentals in support of the Annual Valley Disaster Preparedness Fair which provides Family Emergency Preparedness starter kits, informative presentations, displays and basic trainings, in a family-friendly environment.


