4) Please describe the purpose and intent of the grant.

New Horizons provides social services for individuals with special needs including supported employment and training program, day program, community living and residential support services. The purpose of the grant is to cover the cost of our Holiday Cheer Outdoor Movie Event in the North Hills West Community, an event open to the public. The grant would go to the costs for the provision of services including crew, movie projection, jumbo screen, audio and video equipment, set-up and break-down for the evening. The event will be physically held outdoors in the parking lot at the side of Sam's Cafe on New Horizons' campus, limited to 250 guests with a required RSVP and mask covering per CDC safety guidelines. Guests are being instructed to bring their own folding chair/jacket/blanket. We will have a Sing-Along session and show the movie "Elf" for an enjoyable event. We will provide a table for NHWNC; Santa Claus will make an appearance; hot chocolate & cookies will be available for free. Pre-packaged popcorn/candy available for \$1 per item.

New Horizons holds an annual Holiday Cheer event and this year is special because we are able to have an in-person event for our program members and families, staff, and the public community. While continuting to follow CDC health and safety guidelines, we are excited to welcome folks on campus, outdoors, to bring in the Holiday Season with joy and reengagement with families, local business owners and workers. Our event will promote community vibrancy, safety, and a sense of well-being.

This is in response to your October 31, 2013 request for information regarding your tax-exempt status.
