6. Discussion and possible action to ratify the Board's June 18th approval to encumber \$23,000 of FY 2019-2020 funds for payment in FY 2020-2021 from these 'encumbered' (saved, set-aside) funds.

Motion to authorize payment in *this* fiscal year; using last fiscal year's *encumbered* funds, money which was specifically set-aside for the expenditures appearing on our Encumbrance Request Form.

NC Funding has audited our accounts and granted their approval. Voting to APPROVE this motion (or these motions if voted upon separately) grants NC funding our authorization to withdraw the money from the encumbered funds.

- a. Moore Business Solutions – for Communication Services (website & eBlast News) NTE \$6000.
- b. Verizon Wireless – for the Board Telephone – NTE \$420
- c. Western Medical – for KN95 Masks – NTE \$4999
- d. Western Medical – for purchase of additional PPE (Tri-fold masks and Safety Goggles) – NTE \$1250
- e. The Green Station – for purchase of street & sidewalk clean up equipment – NTE \$750
- f. Adobe – Monthly Software subscription service for Design of Outreach Materials – NTE \$650
- g. Partners in Diversity – Monthly Minute-Taking & Transcription, Administrative Services – NTE \$1772

7. Discussion and possible action to approve a revised Annual Budget, an adjustment to our Rollover Funds from \$10,000 to \$8,359.61 according to the audit and reconciliation conducted by NC Funding from June 30th - Aug 1st.
8. Discussion and possible action to ratify last year's approval of proposed payment for LAPD officers' overtime, in the amount of \$1,959.81, for their after-hours service to provide enhanced security for NHWNC General Board Meetings from July – December 2019. This item was just presented on 9/16/20. Follow-up is needed to confirm that this outstanding debt, while approved, has not yet been paid. Motion to approve, contingent on such, authorizing payment of last fiscal year's debt during this fiscal year's budget may be made from a portion of the amount encumbered for New Horizons meeting overhead expenses. This may be deemed fit – contingent upon final DONE & NC Funding approval – since funds from the last Fiscal Year would be used to pay a debt incurred but apparently not satisfied, in the same Fiscal Year: *both* 2019-2020 at and for the express purpose of conducting the monthly Board meeting.
