Summary of Motions Introduced (*New Legislation*)

Council File 23-0038, Measure ULA / United to House LA / 2021-2029 Housing Element / Implementation (*Hernandez – Raman – Harris-Dawson*): Introduced January 11, 2023 and referred to Budget and Finance Committee. The motion is instructing the Los Angeles Housing Department with assistance from the City Administrative Officer, the City Attorney's Office, the Department of Finance, and any other relevant departments, to report back within 15 days on the implementation of Measure ULA.

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Council File 23-0036, Council Chamber / Public Disruption or Unrest / De-escalation and Mediation / Unarmed Officers (*Hernandez – Soto-Martinez*): Introduced January 11, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The motion is instructing the Civil + Human Rights and Equity Department, with assistance from the Chief Legislative Analyst and the Office of the City Attorney's Mediation program, and in consultation with relevant community-based organizations, violence interrupters, and de-escalation experts, to develop and report on

a mediation-based model for maintaining order in Council Chambers that does not involve armed officers.

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Council File 23-0033, Inside Safe Initiative / Executive Directive No. 2 / Homelessness Crisis / Declaration of Local Emergency / Homelessness Emergency Account / General City Purposes Fund (Krekorian – Price - Raman): Introduced January 10, 2023 and referred to Homelessness and Poverty Committee. The motion is instructing the Controller to establish a new Homelessness Emergency Account within General City Purposes, Fund 100/56, Account No. TBD, to be administered by the Mayor for the purpose of implementing the initial pilot phase of Inside Safe, with funds to be expended by the CAO as authorized and directed by the Mayor.

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Council File 23-0029, Homelessness Response System / Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority / Key Performance Indicators / Contract Management (Park - Krekorian): Introduced January 10, 2023 and referred to Housing Committee. The motion is instructing the Los Angeles Housing Department (LAHD) to report on procedures of contract management with Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA), including how contracts are monitored, performance is measured, and what measures are in place to address underperformance.

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Council File 23-0002-S19, Azerbaijan Attacks Condemnation / Armenian Territory / Armenian Prisoner Release / Human Rights Abuses / Nagorno Karabakh (Krekorian – Rodriguez – Soto-Martinez - Price): Introduced January 10, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 Federal Legislative Program, SUPPORT and SPONSORSHIP of any legislation and administrative action which would condemn Azerbaijan's illegal and unprovoked attack on Armenian territory, and call for other actions, as detailed in the text of the Resolution.

Take Action:

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Council File 23-0002-S17, Local Legislative / Virtual Meetings / Ralph M. Brown Act Amendment (Blumenfield - Krekorian – McOskey) Introduced January 10, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for legislative action that would amend the Ralph M. Brown Act to allow local legal legislative bodies, including appointed boards, commissions, advisory bodies, and Neighborhood Councils, to continue to conduct most meetings virtually in the absence of any special circumstances, subject to appropriate safeguards to ensure full and robust opportunities for public participation, including by persons who lack means of digital access.

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Council File 23-0002-S16 Los Angeles Neighborhood Council System / Remote Meetings / Ralph M. Brown Act Amendment (Lee – Soto-Martinez - Yaroslavsky): Introduced January 10, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. The Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program, Sponsorship or Support for legislation to amend the Ralph M. Brown Act to permit the City of Los Angeles Neighborhood Council system to choose to operate remote meetings indefinitely.
