Council File 23-0187, Board of Rights / Los Angeles Police Department / Los Angeles Administrative Code / Ordinance No 186100 / Los Angeles City Charter Section 1070 (McOsker – Soto-Martinez - Krekorian): Introduced February 17, 2023 and referred to Public Safety Committee. The Motion is requesting the Chief Legislative Analyst, City Attorney, the City Clerk, the Los Angeles Police Department, and the Civil and Human Rights and Equity Department to report back in 90 days on recommendations and implementations plans to modify Section 1070 of the Los Angeles City Charter through various options, which should include alternative models for the Board of Rights, including a modified composition of civilian and sworn personnel serving on a Board; Incorporating binding arbitration as a component of the discipline process, where appropriate and authorizing the Chief of Police to terminate officers

immediately (prior to a Board of Rights or other due process proceeding) in appropriate cases, as to be determined by the severity of the misconduct.
