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Council File 23-1200-S98, Michael Yap / East Los Angeles Area Planning Commission / Commission Appointment (*Mayor*): Introduced April 3, 2023 and referred to Planning and Land Use Management Committee. Mayor's report is relative to the appointment of Mr. Michael Yap to the East Los Angeles Area Planning Commission for the term ending June 30, 2023.

Motion is instructing the City Clerk with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer and the Chief Legislative Analyst to provide information to the public on the Mayor's Proposed 2023-24 Budget and publish the required notices.

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Council File 23-0002-S52, SB 567 (Durazo) / Homeless Prevention Act / Low-Income Renter Protections / Unjust Evictions / Unreasonable Rent Increases (Raman – Harris-Dawson): Introduced April 12, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting the City of Los Angeles to include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Senate Bill 567 (Durazo), the Homelessness Prevention Act, which builds on existing law to better protect California's low-income renters from unjust evictions and exorbitant rent increases.

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Council File 23-0002-S51, AB 963 (Schiavo) / End Foster Are-to-Homelessness Pipeline Act / California Infrastructure and economic Development Bank / Housing Construction Loans (Yaroslavsky – Raman): Introduced April 12, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting the City of Los Angeles to include in is 2023-24 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Assembly Bill 963 (Schiavo), the End the Foster Care-to-Homelessness Pipeline Act.

Resolution is requesting the City of Los Angeles to include in is 2023-24 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Assembly Bill 1185 (Gabriel), which would expand the California State Nonprofit Security Grant Program.

Resolution is requesting the City of Los Angeles to include in is 2023-24 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Senate Bill 85 (Wiener), the California Extended Case Management Act.

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Council File 23-0002-S48, SB 376 (Rubio) / Human Trafficking / Victims Rights / Advocate and Support Person / Notifications / Confidentiality (Park – Rodriguez): Introduced April 12, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting the City of Los Angeles to include in is 2023-24 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Senate Bill 376 to provide human trafficking victims the right to have a human trafficking advocate and support person present during law enforcement and legal interviews, and notifications of their rights and confidentiality limitations.

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Council File 23-0002-S47, AB 1565 (Jones-Sawyer) / Social Equity Program / California Department of Cannabis Control / Controller Funds Disbursement (*Price – Harris-Dawson*): Introduced April 12, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting the City of Los Angeles to include in is 2023-24 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Assembly Bill 1565 (Jones-Sawyer) to require the Controller to appropriate and disburse funding annually that directly furthers the purpose of the Social Equity Program.
