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Council File 23-0452, Spay Neuter Voucher Program / Monetary Value Adjustment / Subsidized Veterinary Services (Hernandez – Soto-Martinez): Introduced April 26, 2023 and referred to Neighborhoods and Community Enrichment Committee. Motion is instructing the Department of Animal Services (DAS) to report back within 90 days on the current DAS spay/neuter voucher program, including amount of vouchers issued annually, the monetary value of the vouchers, the income threshold required to qualify for a voucher, and the number of veterinarians in the City who accept in the vouchers compared to the overall number of veterinarians in the City.

report on the City's immediate and long-term role in the CARE Court program within 60 days.

Resolution resolved that the City Council commemorates May 2023 as Asian American Pacific Islander Heritage Month in the City of Los Angeles and encourages all to use this as a call to action to make our communities more sustainable, equitable, and livable. Resolution further request that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-2024 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for SB 434 (Min) to require California's top ten public transit operators to collect and publish survey data as a critical first step towards addressing street harassment, improving passenger safety, and increasing transit ridership.
