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Council File 23-0530, Ethics and Conflict of Interest Laws / Disclosure Requirement / Registered Lobbyist / Relative / Councilmember or Staff / Lobbying Prohibition (McOsker – Yaroslavsky - Krekorian): Introduced May 16, 2023 and referred to Ad Hoc Committee on City Governance Reform. Motion is requesting the Chief Legislative Analyst, in consultation with the Ethics Department and the City Attorney, to report to the Council within 30 days on whether and how the City could adopt revisions to the ethics and conflict of interest laws.

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Council File 23-0529, Ethics and Conflict of Interest Laws / Disclosure Requirement / Registered Lobbyist / Relative / Councilmember or Staff / Lobbying Prohibition (*Park - Raman*): Introduced May 16, 2023 and referred to Transportation Committee. Motion is requesting the City Attorney to prepare and present an ordinance that amends Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.73.1 to specify that the Code Section includes the rental of RVs as one of the types of vehicles prohibited to conduct their business of selling, leasing, renting, or any other disposition in the public-right-of-way.

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Council File 23-0527, Homelessnes Services Industry Workers / Living Wage / Working Conditions / Cost of Servies / Multi-Year Contracts (*DeLeon - Rodriguez*): Introduced May 16, 2023 and referred to Housing and Homelessness Committee. Motion is requesting that the City Administrative Officer, the Chief Legislative Analyst, the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA), and the City Attorney to work together to prepare an analysis of the factors that determine wages and working conditions for workers at all levels of the Homeless Services Industry and a path forward for ensuring a true living wage for workers in this field.

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Council File 23-0002-S60, SB 710 (Durazo) / California Department of Transportation / State Route 710 Terminus Project Site / Terminus Regional Planning Committee / Potential Land Uses (*DeLeon - Krekorian*): Introduced May 26, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee.

Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-24 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for SB 710 (Durazo), which would require the California Department of Transportation to establish and administer a Terminus Regional Planning Committee to prepare a report for the Legislature relative to potential land uses associated with the former "State Route 710 Terminus Project".

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Council File 23-0002-S59, AB 1620 (Zbur) / Permanent Physical Disabilities / Rent-Controlled Units / Renter Relocation / Accessible Unit / Rental Rate Retention (Soto-Martinez - Yaroslavsky): Introduced May 26, 2023 and referred to Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee. Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-24 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for AB 1620 (Zbur), which would authorize a jurisdiction to require an owner of a rent-controlled unit to allow a permanently physically disabled tenant to relocate to a comparable accessible unit and retain their same rental rate.

Resolution is requesting that the City of Los Angeles include in its 2023-24 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for SB 529 (Gonzalez), the EVs for All Act of 2023

which would require the California Energy Commission to develop and administer a new

competitive grant program to facilitate the establishment of EV car sharing services at affordable housing facilities.
