Summary of Motions Introduced (*New Legislation*)

Council File 23-1200-S149, Tria Blu Wakpa / Cultural Affairs Commission / Commission Appointment (*Mayor*): Introduced October 10, 2023 and referred to Neighborhoods and Community Enrichment Committee. Mayor's report is relative to the appointment of Ms. Tria Blu Wakpa to the Cultural Affairs Commission for the term ending June 30, 2028.

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Council File 23-1134, Economic Roundtable / Economic Study / Annual Rent Increase / Rent Stabilization Ordinance (RSO) / Sole-Source Contract (*Blumenfield – Soto-Martinez – Yaroslavsky*): Introduced October 13, 2023 and referred to Homelessness Committee. Motion is authorizing the Los Angeles Housing Department (LAHD) to negotiate and execute a sole-source contract, subject to eh approval as to form by the City Attorney, with Economic Roundtable, for an amount not to exceed \$180,000 from the Rent Stabilization Trust Fund 43/440, the term of the agreement shall be from date of execution to 12 months to conduct an economic study

of the formula for setting the RSO annual allowable rent increase, with the understanding the study should conclude within 3 months.

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Council File 23-1124, Living Wage Ordinance (LWO) / Fine Provision / Los Angeles Administrative Code / Section 10.37.6(g) (3) / Amendment (McOsker - Krekorian): Introduced October 11, 2023 and referred to Trade, Travel and Tourism Committee. Motion is requesting the City Attorney amend the LWO to ensure that section 10.37.6(g) (3) to comply with the court's decision.

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Council File 23-1114, Los Angeles Neighborhood Councils / SB 411 / Teleconferencing / Remote Meetings / Brown Act Modification / California Government Code / COVID-19 Pandemic (Soto-Martinez - Hutt): Introduced October 10, 2023 and referred Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee scheduled for committee meeting on October 20, 2023. Resolution is requesting the City of Los Angeles with the concurrence of the Mayor to authorize Neighborhood Councils to use teleconferencing pursuant to California Code Section 54953.8.

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Council File 23-1113, Los Angeles Neighborhood Councils / Remote Meetings / SB 411 / Teleconferencing Provisions / Ralph M. Brown Act (Soto-Martinez - Hutt): Introduced October 10, 2023 and referred to Neighborhoods and Community Enrichment Committee. Motion is directing the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment to report back in 30 days on what technology, support and other resources are needed to provide Neighborhood Councils with the ability to meet virtually through the end of Fiscal Year 2024-2025.
